

Minutes of the GMCA meeting of 02-05-20018

Ordinance Issues

Community

There was a motion and second regarding board insurance, and motion and dicussion were adjourned to the March meeting.

Warren Valley Golf Course – The city did sign a contract to purchase the golf course, but the title has not yet been transferred. The council passed a resolution not to develop the golf course for other uses.

Lisa Oshansky voiced the opinion that any new city buildings should not be placed on the golf course land. She would like an ordinance to back up the council resolution; and the

ordinance would say that other uses of the golf course land would be prohibited without a city-wide vote. Other opinions were voiced. A motion was made and seconded to ask the council to pass an ordinance as mentioned above. The motion passed, as 26 of the voting member present voted in favor of the motion, and only one voted against it. Certain non-members complained that they should be allowed to vote on our motion; but it was pointed out that they had made a deliberate decision not to be members of our organization.
